Travel and parking guidance

GETTING THERE BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Train** Bristol Temple Meads train station is only 1 mile approx (taxi approx £6.00).
- Coach/bus** Bristol Bus station is a few hundred metres away.
- Air** Bristol Airport is 10 miles away from Bristol. There is a dedicated express coach service; the Bristol Airport Flyer that runs every 15 minutes during the day. Tickets cost £10.00 return and can be purchased on board.

GETTING THERE BY ROAD

- From the M4 leave at junction 19.
- Follow the M32 right to the end of the motorway which turns into Newfoundland Way (A4044), which then becomes Newfoundland Street.
- Follow Newfoundland Street onto Bond Street (follow signs for Clifton and Bus Station) to the large roundabout (Premier Inn and Beefeater).
- Come right around the roundabout (4th exit) back towards the M32 (there is a Holiday Inn on your left).
- Turn left onto York Street.
- Brunswick Square (where BDP is) is immediately on the right. The post code is BS2 8PE.

REGISTRATION

Registration and refreshments start at 9am. On arrival at Brunswick Square please go to Brunswick Court on Brunswick Square to register. Brunswick Court is the building with 4 big pillars outside the front. There will be lots of conference volunteers wearing yellow t-shirts who can direct you if you are lost. Also the BDP mobile exchange van, a large white van will be parked outside.

PARKING

Road parking There is pay and display parking very near to the conference hall on Brunswick Square, however this is limited to a 2 hour maximum stay. On the square behind Brunswick Square (Portland Square) there is a maximum stay of 4 hours.

Car parks There is long stay parking in the nearby Cabot Circus Car Park and an NCP car park next to the new Holiday Inn hotel on Bond Street – both are a short walk away from the venue.
